Please send your **unwrapped** items to your child's classroom by Friday, December 17 (the last day of school before Christmas Break). Thank you!

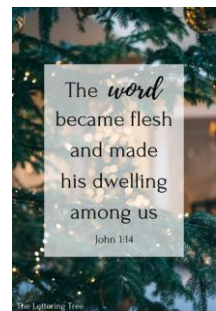

I remember my childhood Children's Christmas services very well. Perhaps some of you do also. I remember starting my 7th grade song one measure before the actual start. I remember saying the wrong Bible passage in 6th grade out loud. I remember the goodie bag of treats after each service. I remember trying to count all the "big kids" in the chairs in the front of church while my Kindergarten class and I sat in the pews. I remember a sweet congregation member telling me she had never seen a 5th grader ring a bell with as much enthusiasm as I had. I remember crying and telling my mom I would never play piano again after messing up my preservice Christmas song of "Joy to the World."

I remember the practicing. SO MUCH PRACTICING. We practiced walking up. We practiced lining up. We practiced walking out and in. We practiced each song a BILLION times. We practiced how to walk out if you had to use the bathroom. We practiced what to do if you were feeling sick. We practiced how to say the recitations. We practiced saying, "Isaiah 9:6-7." The point was never to get it right or else. The point was never to get it right because Grandma and Grandpa came down from Fond du Lac to see this. The point was that we were the pointers. We got to point every person in church to Jesus Christ. We got to point to Christ in our songs. We got to point to Christ in our recitations. We even got to point to Christ in our walking up and walking out. WE GOT TO POINT TO JESUS!!!

What a privilege and blessing that is for our kids at CoL. They get to be the pointers to Christ. May God continue to bless their practicing and performing as they point us and everyone to Christ especially on December 15th and 19th.
