After calling around - and getting a few laughs and comical remarks - I discovered no one had even heard of such a pie at the half-dozen local bakeries I called. I also read this dessert was a favorite of Johnny Cash and decided if it was good enough for the "The Man In Black", then I'd just make my own! I don't recall ever baking a pie before myself, but this recipe was even easy enough for me. This recipe only takes 5, 6, or 7 ingredients, depending on what options you pick. (Note: While this isn't an exact copy, this is pretty close to the online recipes of the "Johnny Cash's Mom's" version.)
