We have longstanding roots in Pennsylvania and this dish is often associated with the Pennsylvania Dutch Amish and Mennonite Communities. There are two styles to this treat: 'Dry' which has a cake-like texture, and 'wet', which has a custard-like bottom. My family always preferred the dry method but as I've learned to make it myself, I prefer the 'wet' pie.
