Thank you also to Bethany Brigham, who has run our Book Fair with excellence for many years. Bethany will be passing the torch after this year. We are thankful for her service to our school!

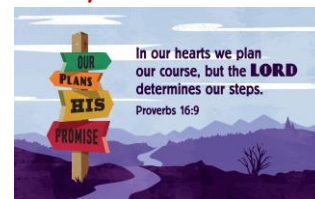
