Enrollment, Registration, & Tuition at Crown of Life for 2024-2025

To assist with more accurate projections for enrollment and finances, the Crown of Life Full-Time Education Committee has implemented an earlier enrollment period for the 2024-2025 school year.

- **January 7-** Re Enrollment and enrollment (for new students in your immediate family) is open for all current school families. Look for enrollment links/information in early January.
- **January 14-** Enrollment for any new students who are members at Crown of Life or our Partner Churches is open.
- **January 21-** Enrollment for any new students from the community is open.

The tuition rates and registration fees for the 2024-2025 school year were approved by the voters at Crown of Life on December 10th. **The registration fee for all students is now \$200 per child.** This fee will begin processing one week after enrollment has been approved. If this presents a hardship, please contact the proper administrator to discuss the situation with them-- either Principal Justin Vilski or Preschool Director Jeanni Kutz.
