


Re: Fine Arts Festival at St. Croix Lutheran Academy - Registration

- ▶ PLEASE NOTE All registration fees will be covered by Crown of Life. Students and parents are responsible for 1) communicating interest in participation to the respective contact person, 2) preparation for the festival, and 3) participating in the festival.
- ▶ <u>Choristers (grades 5-8 students)</u> will perform for judging (time TBD), participate in the mass choir rehearsal at **12:30** pm, and sing in the Festival Concert at **4:00 pm.** Chorister participation in this festival is already established according to the Chorister schedule.
- ► <u>COL Band</u> (grades 6-8) will perform for judging (time TBD), participate in the mass band rehearsal at 12:00 pm, and play in the Festival Concert at 4:00 pm.
- ► Students in grades 5-8 may perform for judging in the areas of vocal solos, duets, and ensembles, instrumental solos, duets, and ensembles, and piano solos and duets. Please communicate your interest to the following teachers:
 - 1. Mrs. Mielke will register all vocal solos and ensembles.
 - 2. Mr. Fenske and Ms. Rieke will register all instrumental solos, duets and ensembles.
 - 3. Mrs. Stokke and Mrs. Kock will register all piano solos.
- ► Art students may also enter artwork for judging (one per student) in the area of drawing, 2-D art, or sculpture. Parents should register their art students using the FAFS link above. Please communicate your interest in submitting art for judging to Mrs. Mielke. Visual artists are invited to attend a morning or afternoon workshop to receive feedback and for skill development practice.
- ▶ Please discuss your plans for participation with the respective teacher by *Wednesday, March 20.* Online registrations are due by Friday, March 22, 2024.



- 1. The bigger your drawing, the better! Use up the whole sheet of paper.
- 2. Don't leave a lot of white space- Lots of bright colors will show up better.
- 3. Be sure your text stands out (i.e. use a lighter color background.)
- 4. Check for spelling errors.
- 5. Mix up your medium. Play with one of more of the following: crayons, watercolors, markers, oil pastels, and digital art
