## **New Teachers**

Please find an opportunity to introduce yourself and warmly welcome these new teachers to Crown of Life.


## Parent Information (Forms, Information and Handbooks)

#### **Band**

Our band program is through St. Croix Lutheran Academy. We are developing a schedule that will work best for both individual and group lessons. All lessons will be held during the school day at Crown of Life. More information will continue to go out to families once schedules are finalized.

**School Year Theme** – "Forever Faithful" is the theme for this upcoming school year. It is based on Psalm 100:5 - "For the LORD is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations." This theme fits very well as it is the school's 150th anniversary this year (2025) celebrating our Lord's faithfulness to a school devoted to Christian education!



## **Administrative Program**

Crown of Life uses a Student Information System called **Gradelink**. Gradelink serves Crown of Life by allowing us to electronically register, record and grade assignments, and communicate with families. If you ever have questions about Gradelink, please communicate with the office and we will help work through any issues.

## **Payment Method**

All tuition payments will be electronically pulled through PaySimple. This is the electronic payment system that integrates with Gradelink. Since many families have filled out ACH forms, most banking information is no longer needed. Mr. Mielke (or our Bookkeeper) will reach out to families that need to fill out an ACH form. Tuition totals will be sent to families by middle/late July for approval or discussion. Once tuition totals are approved, families can sign the document in the office as soon as they are able. Look for communication on this process.

## **Transportation**

**Students in grades K-8 living in District #197** will receive bus information from the district as to the time and place of pickup. This schedule usually arrives by mail from the district about one week before school begins. You must be registered at Crown of Life Lutheran School in order to get on the bus list. Transportation policy states that a student must be transported to the same location five days a week.

The school district requires families to register their transportation needs with the school district. Click <u>here</u> to get started. A form on this site needs to be filled out and returned to the school district office by August 1.

If you are looking for someone with which to carpool, please contact the school office. We will try to help you with names of others in your area.

## **School Hours**

School will begin at 8:00 am and end at 3:10 pm every day for all grades. School doors will open at 7:40 am for all students. The school door used is the door by the flagpole. Please note these times so that your child is properly prepared for the day. We would also ask that you pick your child up promptly at the end of each day. If you are going to be late dropping off or picking up, please call the school office at 651-451-3832.

### **Before School Care**

COL offers Before School Care from 7:00 am - 7:40 am in the Fellowship Hall for students in KINDERGARTEN-8th Grade (at this time we can not support Preschool students in Before School Care) Students should enter through the side door of the Fellowship Hall in the West parking lot. The cost is \$.10 per minute per child. Charges will be billed to your PaySimple account monthly, for the prior month's use.

### **After School Care**

After School Care is offered Monday - Friday from 3:30 - 5:30 pm, except for Early Dismissal days. The cost is \$6.00 per hour per child. ASC may be used as needed. Charges will be billed to your PaySimple account monthly, for the prior month's use.

Currently we can not offer ASC for Preschool aged students. This is due to staffing and licensure parameters. We will continue to look for ways to offer this service to our Preschool families.

Before/After School Care can only be offered if they are fully staffed. It is our intention to offer both services but there is always the possibility that staffing changes the ability to offer the program. Communication will be sent if we are not staffed.

### **Lunch and Milk**

Our lunch program is provided through CKC Good Food. CKC offers these options: hot, cold, hot vegetarian and deli salad. Salad bar and milk is included with each lunch. The cost for lunch is \$4.90 (includes milk); milk only is 75 cents. Due to a price increase by CKC, we have raised our price per lunch by 15 cents this year. A Google form and lunch menu will be sent out from the office by the middle of each month for parents to order lunches. Lunches are ordered once per month, and are due on the date listed on the Google sign up form. Families will be billed for lunch/milk via PaySimple at the beginning of each month for the previous month's orders. Please refrain from sending pop/soda in lunches.

#### **Physical Exams**

Physical exams are required for students entering Kindergarten and those entering Grade 7 who are planning to be in sports. Proper forms for these were distributed in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade report cards and are also available in the school office. A new law is in effect for students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade. All 7<sup>th</sup> graders need TWO measles shots. If your child has had only one shot, he/she will need to receive another shot at this time. A good time to do this is during the 7<sup>th</sup> grade physical.

We are so excited to be a part of your child's journey as we start another school year and pray that God richly blesses our partnership!
